

The company is running a very profitable banking current account with Nedbank Isando, registered in the name of MS Oil trap Solutions, since inception of the business.



Dear Valued Customer

Extended Producer Responsibility for Lubricants

In terms of Section 18 of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, the Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and Environment has issued a notice to the producers of lubricants requiring them to implement compulsory Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) for their lubricants. This legislation was promulgated on 23 March 2023 and places an obligation on all producers of lubricants to take steps to ensure their waste emanating from lubricants is diverted from the environment via a Producer Responsibility Organization (PRO).

The ROSE Foundation is a PRO that was proactively established in 1994 by the lubes industry to implement EPR voluntarily. The notice to the industry now makes it compulsory for all producers to be part of an EPR scheme.

bp Southern Africa (Pty) Ltd, is a member of ROSE Foundation.

Whilst the ROSE Foundation and its members may not prescribe who collects used oil from the premises where used oil is generated, we must emphasize that the oil needs to be collected by someone who is registered with the EPR scheme/s in the lubes industry. All used oil must be collected by someone that is accredited with an EPR scheme responsible for the product. All generators of used oil should therefore ensure that their waste is only collected by collectors who have the relevant accreditation. Currently the ROSE Foundation is the only accredited EPR scheme for the lubricants industry.

4. First Aid Measures

Eye Contact

6. Accidental Release Measures

Personal Precautions

Stocks of suitable absorbent material should be held in quantities sufficient to deal with any spillage.

Clean-up Methods

Protect drains from potential spills to minimise contamination. Protect environmentally sensitive areas and water supplies.

First eliminate ignition sources, and then stop source of release if it can be done without risk of harm. Contain the spill with hydrocarbon-proof dykes to prevent further contamination of soil, groundwater or surface water. Clean-up using appropriate, inert absorbent material that must be disposed of as hazardous waste in accordance with local regulations. DO NOT wash product into drainage. Place sufficient signage around spill indicating a slipping hazard and prevent access to the spill site.

Scrub contaminated area with detergent and water using a stiff broom. Pick up liquid with additional absorbent and place in a disposable container.






